Requirements

Submission Process

Personnel Assignment data can be submitted through eRIDE (www.eride.ri.gov) using the Personnel Data Collection. *Personnel Assignment* is a submission type within the Personnel Data Collection application. LEAs have 2 methods for completing the Personnel Assignment data requirements. LEAs can either import data files or use the application to manually enter, edit and delete records.

Validations

STAFFID – This field must be a valid id in the state staff id system.

CERTIFICATIONID – This field must be a valid id for a certified educator.

LEACODE – This field must be a valid LEA in the RIDE master directory and must also be the district associated with the user that is submitting the data.

SCHCODE – This field must be a valid school in the RIDE master directory and must also be a school within the *LEACODE*.

STAFFFIRSTNAME – This field must match the first name that is available in the certification database.

LOWGRADE– This field must be equal to or less than the value submitted for *HIGHGRADE*.

LOWGRADE – This field is required when the *FEDSTAFFCATEGORY* is Pre-Kindergarten Teachers, Kindergarten Teachers, Elementary Teachers, Secondary Teachers, Ungraded Teachers or Paraprofessional/instructional aides.

HIGHGRADE– This field must be equal to or greater than the value submitted for *LOWGRADE*.

HIGHGRADE – This field is required when the *FEDSTAFFCATEGORY* is Pre-Kindergarten Teachers, Kindergarten Teachers, Elementary Teachers, Secondary Teachers, Ungraded Teachers or Paraprofessional/instructional aides.

TIMEINASSIGNMENT- This field must be a valid decimal between 0.01 and 1.00.

ASSIGNMENTSTARTDATE – This field must be a valid date and must be greater than or equal to the first day of school and less than or equal to the last day of school.

ASSIGNMENTENDDATE – This field must be a valid date and must be greater than or equal to the first day of school and less than or equal to the last day of school.

ASSIGNMENTENDDATE /ASSIGNMENTENDDATEREASON – When *ASSIGNMENTENDDATE* is entered, *ASSIGNMENTENDDATEREASON* must be entered

ASSIGNMENTSTARTDATE /ASSIGNMENTENDDATE– *ASSIGNMENTSTARTDATE* must less than *ASSIGNMENTENDDATE*.

ASSIGNMENTENDDATE/ASSIGNMENTSTARTDATE– *ASSIGNMENTENDDATE* must greater than *ASSIGNMENTSTARTDATE*.

NUMBEROFDAYSWORKED – This field must be a valid number and must be between 1 and 260.

CONTRACTUALDAYS – This field must be a valid number and must be between 1 and 260.

NUMBEROFDAYSWORKED /CONTRACTUALDAYS – *NUMBEROFDAYSWORKED* must be less than or equal to *CONTRACTUALDAYS*.

CERTSTATUSRELATEDSVC– This field is required when *SPEDRELATEDSERVICEPERSONNEL* is SPEECHPATH, PSYCH, PHYSEDTEACHER, MEDICAL or COUNSELORSCH.

LICENSESTATUSRELATEDSVC– This field is required when *SPEDRELATEDSERVICEPERSONNEL* is AUDIO, INTERPRET, OCCTHERAP, PHYSTHERAP, NURSE, SOCIALWORK or SCHNURSETEACHER.

SPEDAGEGROUP – This field is required when *PROGRAMASSIGNMENT* is Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Special Education, Severe Intellectual Disability, or Visually Impaired.

SPEDSTUDENTPERCENT – When applicable, this field must be a valid number between 1 and 100.

SPEDSTUDENTPERCENT – This field is required when *PROGRAMASSIGNMENT* is (Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Special Education, Severe Intellectual Disability, or Visually Impaired) AND *FEDSTAFFCATEGORY* is one of the following: Pre-Kindergarten Teachers, Kindergarten Teachers, Elementary Teachers, Secondary Teachers, Ungraded Teachers, Paraprofessional/instructional aides.

SPEDSTUDENTPERCENT – This field is required when *SPEDRELATEDSERVICEPERSONNEL* is not blank.

SPEDRELATEDSERVICEPERSONNEL – This field is required when *PROGRAMASSIGNMENT* is 'Special Education' and *FEDSTAFFCATEGORY* is Pre-Kindergarten Teachers, Kindergarten Teachers, Elementary Teachers, Secondary Teachers or Ungraded Teachers.

PARAQUALSTATUS – This field is required when *FEDSTAFFCATEGORY* is Paraprofessional/instructional aides.
