

THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GRANTS DATA COLLECTION


PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

This data collection is a result of the newly established Title I 1003(g) School Improvement Grant (SIG) program. The data for this report is primarily reflective of the schools in your district that received school improvement grants from this program to implement RIDE approved School Reform Plans (SRPs). The information RIDE collects about these grants is important because it is used to measure student, teacher, school and district performance, to inform management, budget and policy decisions, and to comply with state and federal reporting mandates.

REPORTING PROCEDURE

To complete the reporting procedure, please follow these five steps:

1. Login to eRIDE (www.eride.ri.gov) with your username and password. (If you do not know your login credentials, please use the password recovery tool on the eRIDE webpage. If you do not have an eRIDE account, contact your local district data manager or the RIDE helpdesk: helpdesk@ride.ri.gov , 222-8400.)
2. Click on the School Improvement Grants icon. If you do not see this icon, the school improvement grants module has not been added to your account. Again, please contact your local district data manager for access, or the RIDE helpdesk.



3. You will be presented with a screen like the following, displaying all schools receiving School Improvement Grants. You must submit a report for each school on the list. Click on a school to proceed:

If the selection is incorrect, please contact your district's local data manager or the eRIDE helpdesk. Once you click submit, you will be redirected to the home screen where you will need to sign-off on your data by clicking on the "Sign Off" button.
