District that made sufficient improvement and is no longer in Intervention Status: Newport

Districts that made sufficient improvement and are no longer in Watch Status: Bristol-Warren, Burrillville, Coventry, Johnston, Lincoln

- Districts that are in need of improvement missed at least one target in at least two school levels (elementary, middle, high) or had at least 40 percent of their schools classified as “in need of improvement, insufficient progress.” *All other districts* met annual targets for 2004 and are not classified.
- Watch Status: 1st year in need of improvement. No intervention at this time.
- Intervention Status: Districts that have been in need of improvement for two or more years in a row are subject to Progressive Support & Intervention under R.I.G.L. 16-7.1-5 and the federal No Child Left Behind Act.
- Delay Status: District was in Intervention Status last year but is no longer classified as “in need of improvement.” District will remain in Intervention Status until it is not classified as “in need of improvement” for two years in a row.
