

## Overview of the Rhode Island Response to Intervention Model

Response to Intervention (RTI) is a process of determining appropriate support and interventions to supplement and intensify the core curriculum to meet the needs of all learners. This framework for instruction bases decisions on benchmark and progress monitoring data to improve achievement. The Rhode Island Response to Intervention initiative has identified five essential components for RTI.

First, RTI is a problem-solving practice.

Second, RTI involves a shared responsibility amongst general education and special education.

Third, RTI requires a school-wide intervention system.

Fourth, RTI is a way to monitor progress.

Fifth, RTI is part of the special education process.





