* The term “continuing” means that a district passed AYP requirements for the 2006-07 school year, but must remain in the intervention status of the prior year. When AYP is passed for two consecutive years, a district is removed from “intervention status.”

Note: To determine whether a school district passes AYP (adequate yearly progress), the general approach is to evaluate elementary schools as a group, middle schools as a group and high schools as a group. In order for each level (elementary, middle, high) to pass AYP, all NCLB accountability targets must be met. If a district misses AYP at all levels within a district or at two of the three levels, the district as a whole does not meet adequate yearly progress (AYP).
