

Action Planning Sessions for RIDE Approved Programs

May 2010

Below are ***dates/times/locations*** for the Action Planning Sessions for RIDE Approved programs planning to move forward with approval for the 2010-2011 school year. Registration information appears on the next page. There will be three sessions in Northern RI and three in Southern RI. Each session focuses on specific standards, and are organized as follows:

Registration

Participants **must** register using Rhode Island Department of Education on-line workshop registration system at www.eride.ri.gov/workshopreg/.

A. Participants who are known to RIDE may enter “user login” and “password”.

B. Participants who are new to RIDE Workshop Registration can create a new user account by clicking on the word “here” at the end of the statement: You may also create a workshop registration account by going **here**. *Be sure to enter accurate email information as this information will be used to contact participants in the event of any changes.*

Once you have entered the system, follow these instructions:

1. “Welcome to the RIDE Workshop Registration System” page will appear. All Action Planning Sessions have the prefix “Comprehensive ECE Programs”.
2. Select the desired session by referring to the description above.
3. Register for the workshop by following these instructions:
 - Click on the title
 - Read the description, date and time.
 - Click on the green “Register” button on the top right side of your screen
 - Click the box adjacent to “Register” on the left side of the panel
 - Click “Register” on the right side.
 - “You have successfully registered for this workshop on the following dates” will appear
 - Sign out

Space is limited to 50 participants per session. In order to accommodate as many programs as possible, please limit registration to individuals directly responsible for action planning. Registration rates will be monitored to determine if additional sessions are warranted.

Directions

Northern RI Collaborative

From Warwick/South County RI Area:

Rt. 95 North to Rt. 295 North to Rt. 146 South Exit 9A. To get onto Rt. 146, stay to the left; once on Rt. 146, move immediately to the right & take the first exit for Rt. 116 North (Albion/Ashton). Bear right at the end of the off-ramp on 116 and proceed straight through to the third set of traffic lights. Take a left u-turn back on Rt. 116 South to the first driveway on the right to the 640 George Washington Highway Office Center. Parking is in the rear of the building; proceed to our offices on the second floor, Suite #200. The Professional Development Training Center conference room is on the lower level, Suite #104.

From Providence RI Area:

Rt. 146 North to the Route 116 exit. At the end of the off-ramp, take a left at the traffic lights onto Rt. 116 North. Stay to the left and at the second traffic light, take a left u-turn back onto Rt. 116 South to the first driveway on the right to the 640 George Washington Highway Office Center. Parking is in the rear of the building; proceed to our offices on the second floor, Suite #200. The Professional Development Training Center conference room is on the lower level, Suite #104.

From East Bay Area:

Rt. 195 West to Rt. 95 North. Take Rt. 146 North to the Rt. 116 exit. At the end of the off-ramp, take a left at the traffic lights onto Rt. 116 North. Stay to the left and at the second traffic light, take a left u-turn back onto Rt. 116 South to the first driveway on the right to the 640 George Washington Highway Office Center. Parking is in the rear of the building; proceed to our offices on the second floor, Suite #200. The Professional Development Training Center conference room is on the lower level, Suite #104.

From Boston Area:

Rt. 95 South to Rt. 295 South to Rt. 146 South Exit 9A. To get onto Rt. 146, stay to the left. Once on Rt. 146, move immediately to the right and take the first exit for Rt. 116 North (Albion/Ashton). Bear right at the end of the off-ramp on 116 and proceed straight through to the third set of traffic lights. Take a left u-turn back on Rt. 116 South to the first driveway on the right to the 640 George Washington Highway Office Center. Parking is in the rear of the building; proceed to our offices on the second floor, Suite #200. The Professional Development Training Center conference room is on the lower level, Suite #104.

University of Rhode Island Kingston Campus

From the north:

Take I-95 South to Exit 9 (Route 4 South) in RHODE ISLAND, follow Route 4 to Route 1 South. Stay on Route 1 until the intersection of Route 138 West. Route 138 West will bring you to the University.

From the south:

Take I-95 North to Exit 3A (Route 138 East). Continue east on Route 138 to the University.

From Newport:

Follow Route 138 West over the Newport and Jamestown bridges to Route 1. Take Route 1 South to Route 138 West. Follow Route 138 West to the University.
